



smART Families Junior Docents

The smART Families Junior Docents program is open to boys and girls grades six and above. As Junior Docents, children will work with a seasoned Museum Docent and gain a broader, deeper knowledge of the exhibitions at the Santa Barbara Museum of Art. In turn, they will apply this knowledge during our Family Events by volunteering to assist the art instructors and lead docents in teaching the younger children. Girls who are members of National Charity League will also be eligible to earn community service hours for their involvement in the program.

What smART Families Junior Docents entails:

Twice a season we will ask the ***smART Families'*** Junior Docents to attend an educational workshop in preparation for an upcoming event. Led by a SBMA Docent, the workshop will allow them to learn about the exhibitions in advance of the events. Additionally, they will be asked to arrive early for each smART Families party so that they are able to prepare for the event and get instruction from the art teachers and lead docents.
