

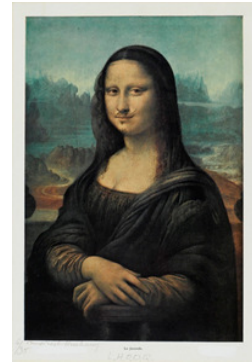


SBMA Travel Summer Stay-cation Series

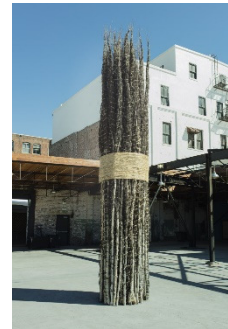
