

Studio Sunday May 2018 Activity Kabuki Stage-Set Illustrations

Create a kabuki stage-set illustration, inspired by works in The Loyal League: Images from Japan's Enduring Tale of Samurai Honor and Revenge now on view at SBMA. Design and color kimono costumes and a stage, considering the seasons and time of day.



For this project, you will need:

- 47 Rōnin Story Illustration
- Watercolor paint
- Paintbrush
- Water

Let's begin!

- 1. Choose an illustration of the 47 ronin story to color with watercolors.
- 2. Think about the time of the day your story takes place.
- 3. Dilute the watercolor paint with water.
- 4. Color in your story with by section so that the watercolors don't blend.
- 5. Add layers of color as you like.
- 6. Let your story illustration dry.
- 7. Enjoy your work!

Tips & Tricks

- If you don't have watercolor paints at home, that's ok! Try coloring you illustration in with crayons, colored pencils, or markers.
- What time of day are you trying to depict in your illustration? Is it early morning? Evening? Maybe you want to try and color a sunset!
- Try coloring your illustration by section so that the watercolor paints don't bleed. If they do mix, that's ok! Can you make the blending of color part of your design?
- Try creating a series of illustrations portraying the ronin story at all different times of day!
